RE: INFORMATION AND REQUEST

Dear Sir,

As the acting president of the Community Action Board (JAC) of the La Segunda Chorrera district, San Martín sector, on my own behalf and that of my whole community, I thank you for your interest in our project. To that end, I would like to share the following with you:

BACKGROUND

We are a community of 302 people, including senior citizens, people with disabilities, and children — an entirely rural community. Our little school, MARCO ANTONIO QUIJANO RICO, San Martín campus, was built more than 60 years ago by our grandparents. Back then we had no access roads or highways, so the materials were carried in on muleback. That little school educated all the young people in our sector. However, over the years, despite our efforts to keep it maintained, the time came to rebuild: the roof was at risk of collapse because its structure was made of wood and, sadly, became infested with weevils that ate through several beams; the walls also showed serious cracking and the damp was quite severe. For all these reasons we had to demolish the entire structure of our school, leaving us with nothing.

To move forward we have the plans and the corresponding permits for the new building. The new foundation includes footings, beams, and concrete for the floors, raising 16 columns that will form the structure of our new school. The façade or front wall will be in exposed structural tolete brick, and the remaining walls will be built with No. 4 block. After raising the masonry, a tie beam of 5/8" steel in 3000 psi concrete will run over the whole structure; on top of it will go a frame of 12-gauge metal profiles, with UPVC thermo-acoustic roofing and, to finish, institutional PVC roofing. It will include 3 tiled bathrooms — two for children and one for people with disabilities — a multipurpose hall for the kitchen and dining area, and a classroom for our little ones.



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NEEDS

As a community, we completed all the relevant procedures to obtain help. Although the municipal administration (the mayor's office) has provided some funds, they are not enough to finish our project. The needs we have and are seeking through donations are:

- Structural tolete brick: 3,000 units
- No. 4 block: 3,000 units
- Argos general-purpose cement: 200 bags
- 120 meters of PVC roofing with its structure
- 2 children's toilets with fittings
- 1 adult toilet with fittings
- 2 tubs of type-1 paint
- Iron windows
- 2 iron gates
- 100 rebar rods (½")
- Stainless-steel sink
- 5 tubs of plastic stucco

This has an estimated value of approximately thirty million pesos (\$30,000,000 COP).

LABOR

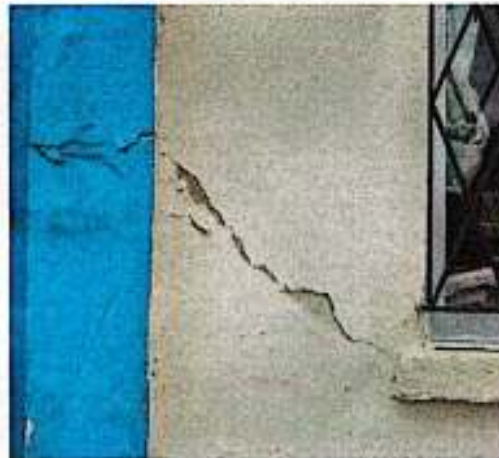
This has a value of twelve million pesos (\$12,000,000 COP) for skilled labor — that is, the master builder and construction foreman — since the helpers are members of our community who contribute their labor at no charge; nevertheless, we still must pay for the skilled labor.
